Nonami Plantation is one of the premier quail plantations in the Albany area and has for the last 20 years produced some of the finest wild quail hunting in the country. This 9,000-acre property on the banks of the beautiful Flint River is also known for its scenery and 18-hole Jack Nicklaus designed golf course. Nonami's detailed approach and intense level of management are unsurpassed and have helped raise the game of quail management even in the heart of the plantation belt. Directions to Nonami - 6420 Hardup Road, Albany, GA 31721 (GPS locator address)

From Albany: Take highway 91 South (Newton Road) past the airport and to the second flashing light at Hardup Road. Turn left on Hardup Road and go 1.9 miles to the main entrance of Nonami which will be on the left.

From Newton: Take Highway 91 North (Albany Highway) until you cross the Dougherty County line and take the first paved road to the right which will be Wildfair Road. Take Wildfair Road 3.3 miles (you will pass Potter's Community Center) until it intersects with Hardup Road where you will turn left and go 2.4 miles to the main entrance of Nonami on the right (you will go past the service entrance).
